TO PRESS PAUSE ON THE FLOW OF TWEETS AND TEXTS, ESCAPE TO A LUSH, OFF-THE-GRID DESTINATION.

IRL friends would do well to consider and Beyond's new Vamizi outpost, part of the Quirimbas Archipelago east of Mozambique. Guests arrive by prop plane and retire to one of six thatched beachfront villas, each with five or six bedrooms, a private staff, and an open-air feel. Kayaks and dhows are on hand to navigate this stretch of the Indian Ocean, whose pristine coral reef is perfect for snorkeling. Wandering inland to explore the mangroves in the nearby nature preserve has its own rewards; look for the hippo (without the pressure of posting).

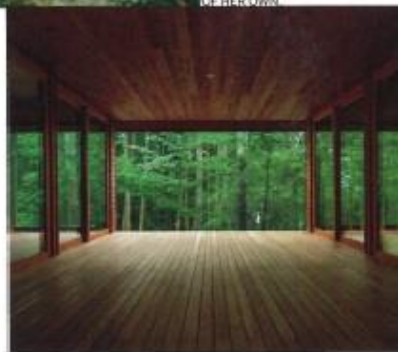
Japan offers plenty of natural splendors of its own, from cherry blossoms to the majestic Mount Fuji, which abuts the site of Hoshinoya Fuji, from Hoshino Resorts. Billed as "glamping on a hill" for the nightly campfires on the "cloud terrace," this sleekly minimalist lodge has 40 guest rooms set among the red pines surrounding Lake Kawaguchi. After stopping at various shrines and teahouses on their way up the volcano, climbers can return to a chef's-choice Dutch-oven

dinner. Roughing it has never been so easy.

For a slightly more pampered getaway, head to Nayara Springs, set in the middle of the Costa Rican rain forest. Nine-

teen new villas feature private decks and individual plunge pools sourced by hot springs, while an elevated pedestrian bridge cuts through the canopy, home to toucans and hummingbirds. Visitors unwind at the cypress-and-teak-floored yoga pavilion and at the award-winning spa offering volcanic mud wraps. Internet connection at this remote tropical resort is actually quite strong, but upon request the staff will kindly lock away your phone.—K.G.
