



BATELEUR CAMP

Set among the forests at the edge of Kenya's Masai Mara, and Beyond's Bateleur Camp, currently undergoing a renovation by Johannesburg-based Fox Browne Creative set for an early 2018 debut, will tell the story of Africa, paying homage to the "safari-goers of old," like Ernest Hemingway and Karen Blixen, says Mark Wheeler, and Beyond's regional managing director for East Africa, South Asia, and South America. "It's about merging the Old World of the safari with the new world of comfort and luxury that the modern traveler has come to expect." Both the perfect place to spot herds of animals and relax by the pool, the camp's facilities will double the size of the nine tents to 1,044 square feet, expanding on the panoramas visible from every location, while adding built-in daybeds on private verandas, open-air stone courtyards, and "star baths" that are covered by a glass roof for "bathing under the African sky," he says. Two new pools act as a refreshing retreat and extensive decking allows for outdoor dining, while the coffee bar will convert into a gin bar by night for the perfect sundowner.
